#### OTHER CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

VALID FROM 01/04/1996

#### *The Development of Rural Wales Act 1976 (c. 75)*

- 53 (1) In section 1 of the Development of Rural Wales Act 1976 (establishment and general function of Development Board for Rural Wales)—
- (a) in subsection (2), for “the county of Powys and the districts of Ceredigion and Meirionnydd” substitute “ the area for which it was so responsible immediately before 1st April 1996 ”; and
  - (b) in subsection (4), in paragraphs (a) and (b), for “and of each district” substitute “ or county borough ”.
- (2) In section 34 of that Act (interpretation), in the definition of “local authority” in subsection (1), for “of a district” substitute “ or county borough ”.
- (3) In paragraph 3(3)(a) of Schedule 1 to that Act (constitution etc of the Development Board for Rural Wales), for “and of each district” substitute “ or county borough ”.
- (4) In Schedule 3 to that Act (the new towns code)—
- (a) omit paragraph 1(6); and
  - (b) in paragraph 38(2)—
    - (i) in sub-paragraph (i), for “district planning authority in whose area the land is situated” substitute “ local planning authority ”; and
    - (ii) in sub-paragraph (ii), at the end add “if they are not the local planning authority”.
