



# Deregulation and Contracting Out Act 1994

## 1994 CHAPTER 40

### PART III

#### SUPPLEMENTARY

#### 80 Financial provisions.

(1) There shall be paid out of money provided by Parliament—

- (a) any sums required by a Minister of the Crown, an office-holder [<sup>F1</sup>or the Forestry Commissioners] for making payments under contracts entered into under or by virtue of Part II of this Act;
- (b) any administrative expenses incurred by a Minister of the Crown or office-holder in consequence of the provisions of this Act; and
- (c) any increase attributable to this Act in the sums so payable under any other Act.

(2) In this section—

“Minister of the Crown” has the same meaning as in <sup>M1</sup> the Ministers of the Crown Act 1975;

“office-holder” has the same meaning as in Part II of this Act.
