    - (b) as regards property subject to a restraint order under section 28(1)(b) of this Act, in accordance with section 30(5) of this Act.
  - (3) References in this Schedule to property held by a person include a reference to property vested in the [F3 trustee (or interim trustee)] in his sequestration or in his trustee in bankruptcy or liquidation.
