ORGANISATION OF POLICE FORCES

[^{F1}General provisions]

[^{F1}23E Collaboration agreements: publication

- (1) A person who makes a collaboration agreement must—
 - (a) publish the agreement, or
 - (b) publish the fact that the agreement has been made and such other details about it as the person thinks appropriate.
- (2) [^{F2} In a case where information is notified to a chief officer of police under section 23D(2), that information] must be published by the chief officer with the information under subsection (1).]
