PROVISIONS SUPPLEMENTARY TO SECTIONS 30 AND 31

Postponement of priority of charge

- 6 A spouse [^{F1}or civil partner] entitled by virtue of section 31 to a charge on an estate or interest may agree in writing that any other charge on, or interest in, that estate or interest shall rank in priority to the charge to which that spouse [^{F1}or civil partner] is so entitled.
