### CHAPTER I

#### CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

#### *Special educational provision: general*

#### **315 Review of arrangements.**

- (1) A local education authority shall keep under review the arrangements made by them for special educational provision.
- (2) In doing so the authority shall, to the extent that it appears necessary or desirable for the purpose of co-ordinating provision for children with special educational needs, consult [<sup>F1</sup>the governing bodies of community, foundation and voluntary and community and foundation special schools [<sup>F2</sup>and maintained nursery schools ] in their area.].
