1997 CHAPTER 10

Miscellaneous provisions

27 Registers etc.

- (1) Every planning authority shall keep, in such manner as may be prescribed, a register containing such information as may be so prescribed with respect to—
- applications for hazardous substances consent made to that authority,
 - applications under section 15(1) made to that authority,
 - hazardous substances consent having effect by virtue of section 9, [F1 10, 10A or 30D] with respect to land for which that authority is the planning authority,
 - revocations or modifications of hazardous substances consent granted with respect to such land, and
 - directions under section 26 sent to the authority by the Secretary of State,
- and every such register shall also contain such information as may be prescribed as to the manner in which applications for hazardous substances consent have been dealt with.
- (2) Every register kept under this section shall be available for inspection by the public at all reasonable hours.
