Supplementary

- 5 Short title, commencement and extent.
 - (1) This Act may be cited as the Land Registration Act 1997.
 - (2) The following provisions, namely—
 - (a) section 1,
 - (b) Part I of Schedule 1 and section 4(1) so far as relating thereto, and
 - (c) Part I of Schedule 2 and section 4(2) so far as relating thereto,

come into force on such day as the Lord Chancellor may appoint by order made by statutory instrument; and different days may be so appointed for different purposes.

(3) Otherwise this Act comes	into force at the end	d of the period of tw	o months beginning
with the day on which it is	passed.	•

- (6) An order under subsection (2) above may contain such transitional provisions and savings as the Lord Chancellor considers appropriate in connection with the order.
- (7) This Act extends to England and Wales only.
