



Firearms (Amendment) (No. 2) Act 1997

1997 CHAPTER 64

1 Prohibition of small-calibre pistols.

In paragraph (aba) of section 5(1) of the ^{M1}Firearms Act 1968 (which describes a category of prohibited weapons consisting of all firearms less than 30 cm. in barrel length or 60 cm. in overall length, other than specified kinds of firearm) the words “a small-calibre pistol” shall cease to have effect.
