SUBMARINE PIPELINES

14 Construction and use of pipelines.

- (1) No person shall—
 - (a) execute in, under or over any controlled waters any works for the construction of a pipeline; or
 - (b) use a controlled pipeline of which the construction was begun on or after 1st January 1976,

except in accordance with an authorisation given in writing by the [FIOGA].

(2) In this Part of this Act—

"controlled pipeline" means so much of any pipeline as is in, under or over controlled waters; and

"controlled waters" means the territorial sea adjacent to the United Kingdom and the sea in any area designated under section 1(7) of the MIContinental Shelf Act 1964.
