ADMISSION APPEALS

PART I

CONSTITUTION OF APPEAL PANELS

Allowances for members

- of the Local Government Act 1972, that provision shall apply, with any necessary modifications, to any member of an appeal panel constituted in accordance with paragraph 1 or 2 (or in accordance with either of those paragraphs as it applies by virtue of paragraph 3 or 4) as it applies to any member of a parish or community council; and such an appeal panel shall be included in the bodies to which section 174 of that Act (travelling and subsistence allowances) applies.
 - (2) In section 174(1) of that Act, in its application to a panel in accordance with subparagraph (1), the reference to payments at rates determined by the body in question shall be read as a reference to payments at rates determined—
 - (a) by the authority, if the panel is constituted in accordance with paragraph 1 (or in accordance with that paragraph as it applies by virtue of paragraph 4); and
 - (b) otherwise by the governing body or bodies of the school or schools in question.
