#### PROCEEDINGS IN NORTHERN IRELAND

##### *Reference of devolution issue to Court of Appeal*

- 28 A court, other than the [<sup>F1</sup>Supreme Court] or the Court of Appeal in Northern Ireland, may refer any devolution issue which arises in any proceedings before it to the Court of Appeal in Northern Ireland.
