## 1999 CHAPTER 18

### *Miscellaneous and supplemental*

#### **16 Devolution.**

- (1) Any function of the Secretary of State under section 1 or 18(3)<sup>F1</sup>... is exercisable only after consultation with the National Assembly for Wales.
- (2) For the purposes of the <sup>M1</sup>Scotland Act 1998, any provision of this Act which extends to Scotland is to be taken to be a pre-commencement enactment within the meaning of that Act.
