- 17 For the purposes of sections 21 and 22 of the ^{M1}Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 (seized material: access, copying and retention)—

 - (b) material produced in pursuance of an order under paragraph 5 shall be treated as if it were material seized by a constable.
