NORTHERN IRELAND

Powers of arrest, search, &c.

90 Power of entry.

- (1) An officer may enter any premises if he considers it necessary in the course of operations for the preservation of the peace or the maintenance of order.
- (2) In this section “officer” means—
 - (a) a member of Her Majesty’s forces on duty, or
 - (b) a constable.
