LOCAL AUTHORITY SERVICES

50 Annual returns.

- (1) Regulations may require a local authority to make to the [FICIECSS] an annual return containing such information with respect to the exercise by the local authority of relevant functions as may be prescribed.
- (2) Provision may be made by the regulations as to the period in respect of which and date by which the return is to be made.
