ELECTIONS

84 Meaning of "local authority" and "principal council" in Part IV

(1) In relation to England—

"local authority" means a principal council or a parish council, "principal council" means a county council, a district council or a London borough council.

(2) In relation to Wales—

"local authority" means a principal council or a community council, "principal council" means a county council or a county borough council.

(3) This section applies for the purposes of this Part.
