



Census (Amendment) Act 2000

2000 CHAPTER 24

1 Particulars in respect of religion may be required.

(1) In the Schedule to the ^{M1}Census Act 1920 (matters in respect of which particulars may be required), after paragraph 5 there shall be inserted—

“5A Religion.”

(2) In section 8 of that Act (penalties), after subsection (1) there shall be inserted—

“(1A) But no person shall be liable to a penalty under subsection (1) for refusing or neglecting to state any particulars in respect of religion.”
