#### DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

#### Prohibition on disclosure

- 1 (1) This Schedule applies to information if—
  - (a) it was obtained by virtue of this Act (other than section 62 or 118), and
  - (b) it relates to the affairs of an individual or to a particular business [F1, and
  - (c) it is not information within section 29(3) of the Consumers, Estate Agents and Redress Act 2007 (application of disclosure regime in Part 9 of the Enterprise Act 2002 to information obtained by the Council).]
  - (2) The information shall not be disclosed during the lifetime of the individual or so long as the business is carried on, except as provided below.

# Offence
