Constitution

- 6 (1) The Board shall consist of 19 members of whom—
 - (a) 10 shall be nominated from among members of the Assembly in accordance with paragraph 7; and
 - (b) 9 shall be appointed by the [FIMinister of Justice] in accordance with paragraph 8.
 - (2) In this Part—

"independent member" means a member of the Board appointed under sub-paragraph (1)(b);

"political member" means a member of the Board nominated under subparagraph (1)(a).
