PART III

MEMBERSHIP DURING DEVOLVED GOVERNMENT

Constitution

- 6 (1) The Board shall consist of 19 members of whom—
- (a) 10 shall be nominated from among members of the Assembly in accordance with paragraph 7; and
 - (b) 9 shall be appointed by the [^{F1}Minister of Justice] in accordance with paragraph 8.
- (2) In this Part—
- “independent member” means a member of the Board appointed under sub-paragraph (1)(b);
 - “political member” means a member of the Board nominated under sub-paragraph (1)(a).
- [^{F2}“transitional period” means the period for which independent members of the Board are appointed in accordance with paragraph 8(4A).]
