Remuneration and allowances of members

- 12 (1) The Board may pay to the chairman, vice-chairman and other members of the Board such remuneration and allowances as the [FIMinister of Justice] may determine.
 - (2) If a person ceases to be a member of the Board otherwise than on the expiry of his term of office and it appears to the [FIMinister of Justice] that there are special circumstances which make it right for that person to receive compensation, the [FIMinister of Justice] may direct the Board to make to the person a payment of such amount as the [FIMinister of Justice] may determine.
