#### TRANSITIONALS AND SAVINGS ABOUT RAILWAYS

##### *Section 56 of the Transport Act 1962*

- 10 Where provision is made for subsections (4) to (6) of section 56 of the <sup>M1</sup>Transport Act 1962 (functions of Rail Passengers' Council and [<sup>F1</sup>London Transport Users' Committee]) to apply in relation to any services or any facilities connected with any services—
- (a) [<sup>F2</sup>section 76] of the <sup>M2</sup>Railways Act 1993 shall not apply in relation to them unless the services are being provided under a franchise agreement, but
- (b) [<sup>F3</sup>that subsection] shall not apply in relation to them if the services are being so provided.
