# Appointment of investigators

# 167 Appointment of persons to carry out general investigations.

- (1) If it appears to [FI an investigating authority] that there is good reason for doing so, the investigating authority may appoint one or more competent persons to conduct an investigation on its behalf into—
  - (a) the nature, conduct or state of the business of [F2 a person to whom subsection (1A) applies or] an appointed representative;
  - (b) a particular aspect of that business; or
  - (c) the ownership or control of [F3 a person to whom subsection (1A) applies].

# [<sup>F4</sup>(1A) This subsection applies to the following persons—

- (a) a recognised investment exchange;
- (b) an authorised person;
- (c) a relevant parent undertaking of an FCA investment firm;
- (d) a person who provides a service to an FCA investment firm or to a relevant parent undertaking of such a firm.]
