SHORT SELLING

Breach of short selling [^{F1}regulation]etc

[^{F1}131H Procedure and right to refer to Tribunal

- (1) If the [^{F2}FCA] proposes to take action against a person under section 131G, it must give the person a warning notice.
- (2) A warning notice about a proposal to impose a penalty must state the amount of the penalty.
- (3) A warning notice about a proposal to publish a statement must set out the terms of the statement.
- (4) If the [^{F2}FCA] decides to take action against a person under section 131G, it must give the person a decision notice.
- (5) A decision notice about the imposition of a penalty must state the amount of the penalty.
- (6) A decision notice about the publication of a statement must set out the terms of the statement.
- (7) If the [^{F2}FCA] decides to take action against a person under section 131G, the person may refer the matter to the Tribunal.]
