Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 (c.22)

- 4 In section 22(2A)(d) of that Act (registration regulations about nil licences)—
- (a) after “State” there shall be inserted “ any ”;
 - (b) after “particulars” there shall be inserted “ and any such documentary or other evidence ”; and
 - (c) after “make” there shall be inserted “ any ”.
