



# Sex Discrimination (Election Candidates) Act 2002

## 2002 CHAPTER 2

### 3 Expiry

- (1) This Act shall expire at the end of [<sup>F1</sup>2030] unless an order is made under this section.
- (2) At any time before this Act expires the [<sup>F2</sup>Secretary of State] may by order provide that subsection (1) shall have effect with the substitution of a later time for the time specified there (whether originally or by virtue of a previous order).
- (3) An order under this section shall be made by statutory instrument; but no order shall be made unless a draft has been laid before, and approved by resolution of, each House of Parliament.
