First class of ineligible person: refugee status abroad

- 4 (1) Paragraph 1 applies to a person if he—
- (a) has refugee status abroad, or
 - (b) is the dependant of a person who is in the United Kingdom and who has refugee status abroad.
- (2) For the purposes of this paragraph a person has refugee status abroad if—
- (a) he does not have the nationality of an EEA State ^{F1}and is not a British citizen], and
 - (b) the government of an EEA State ^{F2}... has determined that he is entitled to protection as a refugee under the Refugee Convention.
