#### MONEY

##### *Miscellaneous receipts*

- 23 (1) The Secretary of State<sup>F1</sup>... may pay money to the Distributor for the purpose of enabling it to meet expenditure.
- (2) A payment under sub-paragraph (1)—
- (a) may not be used to make grants or loans under section 30,
  - (b) may be made only where the Secretary of State<sup>F1</sup>... thinks the Distributor's income is or is likely to be insufficient to meet the expenditure to which the payment relates, and
  - (c) may be made on conditions (which may include conditions about repayment).
