#### **2004 CHAPTER 7**

 $I^{FI}$ Issue of full certificate after interim certificate: applicant married  $I^{FI}$  or a civil partner]

### [F14B Application under section 4A: death of spouse [F2 or civil partner]

- (1) In a case where an application is made under section 4A(2) <sup>F3</sup>... and the applicant's spouse [F4 or civil partner] dies before the application is determined—
  - (a) the application is to be treated as an application, made under section 5(2) in a case where a spouse has died [F5 or under section 5A(2) in a case where a civil partner has died], for a full gender recognition certificate to be issued; and
  - (b) that application is to be treated as having been made at the time when the application under section 4A was made.
- (2) The Gender Recognition Panel determining the application must specify the period within which the applicant is to produce the required evidence in support of the new application.
- (3) In this section—
  - "new application" means the application under section 5(2) [<sup>F6</sup>or (as the case may be) section 5A(2)] which the person is, by virtue of subsection (1), treated as having made;
  - "required evidence" means the evidence required by section 5(4) [ $^{F7}$ or (as the case may be) section 5A(4)]. ]
