#### Pollution

#### 105 Offences relating to pollution etc: penalties on conviction

- In paragraph 25 of Schedule 1 to the Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999 (c. 24) (purposes for which regulations may be made under section 2: offences), in sub-paragraph (2)(a)—
  - (a) in paragraph (i) for "six months" substitute "12 months";
  - (b) in paragraph (ii) for "£20,000" substitute " £50,000 ".
- (2) [<sup>F1</sup>Subsection (1)(a)] does not have effect in relation to regulations under section 2 of the Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999 so far as relating to offences committed before [<sup>F2</sup>2 May 2022].
