Chapter 5 – Inspection of CAF/CASS functions

Section 144: Power of entry

596. This section gives the Chief Inspector the power to enter any premises occupied by CAF/CASS and any organisations or individuals contracted to carry out functions on behalf of CAF/CASS. The Chief Inspector does not have the right to enter private dwellings. The power of entry may be exercised at reasonable times only.
