The Secretary of State and the health service in England

[^{F1}1E Duty as to research

In exercising functions in relation to the health service, the Secretary of State must [^{F2}facilitate or otherwise] promote—

- (a) research on matters relevant to the health service, and
- (b) the use in the health service of evidence obtained from research.]
