Other functions of [^{F1}the consumer advocacy bodies]

18 Secretary of State's power to require reports

- (1) The Secretary of State may direct [^{F1}the GCCNI] to prepare, and submit to the Secretary of State within a specified period, a report in respect of any matter specified in the direction which relates to consumer matters [^{F2} which relate to postal services in Northern Ireland].
- (2) The Secretary of State may publish any report submitted under this section.
