NOTIFICATION ORDERS

Application for notification order

- 5 (1) In Scotland an application for a notification order in respect of a person may only be made by [FI the chief constable of the Police Service of Scotland].
 - (2) An application may only be made if—
 - (a) the person resides in [F2Scotland], or
 - (b) the chief constable believes that the person is in, or is intending to come to, $[^{F3}Scotland]$.
 - (3) The application must be made to the Court of Session.
