NOTIFICATION ORDERS

Application for notification order

- 5 (1) In Scotland an application for a notification order in respect of a person may only be made by [^{F1}the chief constable of the Police Service of Scotland] .
- (2) An application may only be made if—
- (a) the person resides in [^{F2}Scotland] , or
 - (b) the chief constable believes that the person is in, or is intending to come to, [^{F3}Scotland] .
- (3) The application must be made to the Court of Session.
