Offences and monitoring

48 Offences of providing false or misleading information

In section 80(1)(a) of the Pensions Act 2004 (c. 35) (offences of providing false or misleading information)—

- (a) at the end of sub-paragraph (iv) insert “or
 (“) regulations under section 11 of the Pensions Act
 2008,”;
- (b) omit “or” at the end of sub-paragraph (iii).
