- (4) In subsection (3)—
- (a) in paragraph (a) for “section 49G(7) of the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 (c. 50)” substitute “section 190(7) of the Equality Act 2010”, and
- (b) for paragraph (c)(iv) substitute—
