SCHEDULE 3

ABSENT VOTING IN THE REFERENDUM

PART 2

NORTHERN IRELAND

Offences

- 20 (1) A person who—
- (a) in any declaration or form used for any of the purposes of this Part of this Schedule, makes a statement knowing it to be false, or
 - (b) attests an application under paragraph 15 knowing—
 - (i) that he or she is not authorised to do so, or
 - (ii) that it contains a statement which is false,
- is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale.
- (2) A person who provides false information in connection with an application under paragraph 15(1) or 19(4) is guilty of an offence.
- (3) Subsections (3) to (7) of section 13D of the 1983 Act apply for the purposes of subparagraph (2) as they apply for the purposes of subsection (1A) of that section.
