POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONERS: ELECTIONS AND VACANCIES

Elections: further provision

75 The appropriate officer

- (1) For each police area, other than the metropolitan police district, the Secretary of State [^{F1}or the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster] must by order designate a local authority.
- (2) In this Chapter, the "appropriate officer", in relation to any such police area, means the head of paid service of the local authority designated for that police area.
- (3) In this section—
 - "local authority" means-
 - (a) a district council,
 - (b) a county council in England for a county in which there are no district councils,
 - (c) the Council of the Isles of Scilly,
 - (d) a county council or county borough council in Wales;

"head of paid service", in relation to a council, means the person designated by the council under section 4(1)(a) of the Local Government Act 1989. Status: Point in time view as at 12/08/2015.
