Elections: further provision

# 75 The appropriate officer

- (1) For each police area, other than the metropolitan police district, the Secretary of State F1... must by order designate a local authority.
- (2) In this Chapter, the "appropriate officer", [F2means—
  - (a) in relation to a police area in England, the head of paid service of the local authority designated for that police area;
  - (b) in relation to a police area in Wales, the chief executive of the local authority designated for that police area.]
- (3) In this section—
  - [F3cchief executive" means the person appointed by a county council or county borough council in Wales under section 54 of the Local Government and Elections (Wales) Act 2021;]
    - "local authority" means—
    - (a) a district council,
    - (b) a county council in England for a county in which there are no district councils.
