PART 2

INTERVENTION IN APPEAL

Application for permission to intervene in appeal

- 4 (1) Where an application is made under paragraph 1 for permission to appeal against a decision, an application for permission to intervene in the appeal may be made to the [^{F1}Competition and Markets Authority] by another person who would be entitled to appeal against the decision.
 - (2) An application for permission to intervene may be made before the end of the period of 1 week beginning with the day [^{F2}of publication of the Competition and Markets Authority's] decision to grant permission to appeal against the decision.
 - (3) An application for permission to intervene may be made after the end of that period only with the leave of an authorised member of the [^{F3}Competition and Markets Authority].
 - (4) The applicant must send a copy of the application to the CAA.
 - (5) The CAA must—
 - (a) publish the application, and
 - (b) send a copy of the application to the persons listed in sub-paragraph (6) (other than the applicant).
 - (6) Those persons are—
 - (a) the holder of the licence that is the subject of the application for permission to appeal,
 - (b) any other person with a qualifying interest in the decision that is the subject of that application, and
 - (c) such bodies representing airport operators or providers of air transport services as the CAA considers appropriate.
