Meeting needs for care etc.

## 8 How to meet needs

- (1) The following are examples of what may be provided to meet needs under sections 18 to 20—
  - (a) accommodation in a care home or in premises of some other type;
  - (b) care and support at home or in the community;
  - (c) counselling and other types of social work;
  - (d) goods and facilities;
  - (e) information, advice and advocacy.
- (2) The following are examples of the ways in which a local authority may meet needs under sections 18 to 20—
  - (a) by arranging for a person other than it to provide a service;
  - (b) by itself providing a service;
  - (c) by making direct payments.

# [F1(3) "Care home"—

- (a) has the meaning given by section 3 of the Care Standards Act 2000 in respect of a care home in England; and
- (b) means a place in Wales at which a care home service within the meaning of Part 1 of the Regulation and Inspection of Social Care (Wales) Act 2016 (anaw 2) is provided wholly or mainly to persons aged 18 or over.]
