2015 CHAPTER 23

An Act to make provision for the taking of action in relation to horses which are on land in England without lawful authority; and for connected purposes. [26th March 2015]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
