

Psychoactive Substances Act 2016

2016 CHAPTER 2

Offences

10 Penalties

- (1) A person guilty of an offence under any of sections 4 to 8 is liable—
 - (a) on summary conviction in England and Wales—
 - (i) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding [F1the general limit in a magistrates' court] (or 6 months, if the offence was committed before [F22 May 2022]), or
 - (ii) to a fine,

or both;

- (b) on summary conviction in Scotland—
 - (i) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months, or
 - (ii) to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum,

or both

- (c) on summary conviction in Northern Ireland—
 - (i) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months, or
 - (ii) to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum,

or both;

- (d) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 7 years or a fine, or both.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under section 9 is liable—
 - (a) on summary conviction in England and Wales—
 - (i) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding [F3the general limit in a magistrates' court] (or 6 months, if the offence was committed before [F42 May 2022]), or
 - (ii) to a fine,

or both;

(b) on summary conviction in Scotland—

- (i) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 12 months, or
- (ii) to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum, or both;
- (c) on summary conviction in Northern Ireland—
 - (i) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months, or
 - (ii) to a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum, or both;
- (d) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years or a fine, or both.
