Pavement licences

4 Duration

- [F1(1) A pavement licence may be granted by a local authority for such period as the authority may specify in the licence.
 - (2) The period specified may not exceed two years.]
 - (3) Where a pavement licence is deemed to be granted under section 3(9) it is ^{F2}... deemed to be granted for [F3 two years] starting with the first day after the determination period.
- - (5) The licence-holder may surrender a pavement licence at any time by giving notice to the local authority by which it is granted or deemed to be granted.
 - (6) A notice under subsection (5) must be made in writing and sent using electronic communications in such manner as the local authority may specify.
