## 1906 CHAPTER 41 6 Edw 7

DISCLOSURE AND REPRESENTATIONS

### 17 Insurance is uberrimæ fidei.

A contract of marine insurance is a contract based upon the utmost good faith, and, if the utmost good faith be not observed by either party, the contract may be avoided by the other party.
