#### Supplementary Provisions

### 176 Provisions as to exemptions, &c.

- (1) Any power conferred by this Act or regulations [<sup>F1</sup>or health and safety regulations which expressly apply to all mines <sup>F2</sup>..., any class of mines <sup>F2</sup>... or a particular mine <sup>F2</sup>...] on [<sup>F3</sup>the Health and Safety Executive] or an inspector to grant, give or impose an exemption, consent, approval, authority, direction, requirement, prohibition or restriction or to make a determination shall be construed as including a power exercisable in the like manner and subject to the like conditions, if any, to vary or revoke the exemption, consent, approval, authority, direction, requirement, prohibition, restriction or determination.
- (2) Any exemption, consent, approval or authority granted or given under this Act or regulations [<sup>F1</sup>or such health and safety regulations] by [<sup>F3</sup>the Health and Safety Executive] or an inspector may (subject to any express provision of this Act or regulations [<sup>F1</sup>or such health and safety regulations)] be without limit of period or limited so as to expire on a specified date unless renewed, and may be absolute or conditional.
