Measures for Avoiding Accidents to Children

Power to prohibit children from riding on or driving vehicles, machinery or

implements used in agriculture.
(1)
(3) A person who causes or permits a child, in contravention of the provisions of
regulations under this section, to ride on or drive a vehicle or machine or, as the case
may be, to ride on an agricultural implement, shall be guilty of an offence.
