4 Winding up of Road Fund.

- (2) After the winding up of the Road Fund any expenditure incurred by [^{F2}the Secretary of State] which would otherwise have been defrayed out of the Road Fund shall be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament and—
 - (a) any reference in any enactment to the making of payments out of the Road Fund shall be taken as a reference to the making of payments out of moneys provided by Parliament;
 - (b) any reference in any enactment to the making of payments into the Road Fund shall be taken as a reference to the making of payments into the Exchequer.
- - (4) On the winding up of the Road Fund the consequential amendments specified in the First Schedule to this Act shall take effect, . . . ^{F4}
